

## GCSE History Trip to London

Dear Parent/Guardian,

As part of the History GCSE course students will be studying Crime and Punishment as an examined unit. In order to bring this unit to life and give students more of a contextual understanding of London during these time periods, the History department intends to run a trip to visit various attractions and places of historical significance in London.

The trip will take place over two days: Thursday 20th June and Friday 21st June 2019.

Students will need to be at Teignmouth train station at 07:15am, prompt, on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> June ready to travel to London by train. We will return on Friday 21st June, arriving at the train station at 21.54pm. The times of the trains may change so please bear this in mind. We will, of course, inform you of any changes.

Whilst in London, students will:

- Visit the Imperial War Museum
- Visit the London Dungeons
- Take the Jack The Ripper Whitechapel Tour
- Stay in University accommodation overnight
- Visit the Tower of London

The cost of the trip will be approximately £250. This amount could change slightly closer to the time depending on the price of the train tickets. This price includes all travel, accommodation, meals at the University and all attraction entry costs. However, while the University will be providing a packed lunch for the students on the second day, they will be expected to purchase their own evening meal from one of the many food outlets near the London Dungeons. This will be their last opportunity for food before we board the train for our return journey to Teignmouth. Students are also encouraged to bring spending money with them (up to £20).

Places will be allocated on a first come first pay basis and will be subject to good behaviour in school. There are 25 available places. A non-refundable £50 payment is requested to secure your child's place. This is available on ParentPay ([www.parentpay.com](http://www.parentpay.com)). Due to the overnight nature of the trip, if there is a serious cause for concern with regards to any students' behaviour in school prior to the trip, they may be removed from the trip and their place offered to another student.
