<p>English</p>	<p>When and where will my home learning be set? <i>This will be set every Monday by your class teacher on Google Classroom or ClassCharts.</i></p> <p>My online lesson will be... <i>Once a week, either a YouTube clip or a video uploaded to ClassCharts/Google Classroom</i></p> <p>The resources I need will be.. <i>Paper and pen (you can complete on the computer/tablet etc if you prefer). You may want highlighters/different coloured pens to help with annotations.</i></p> <p>I should submit my work... <i>Once a week to your own English teacher.</i></p>
<p>Maths</p>	<p>When and where will my home learning be set? <i>Through ClassCharts.</i></p> <p>My online lesson will be... <i>A 'unit test' with solutions. There will also be a video clip of the test being completed with explanations. There will also be directions explain where to go when you didn't understand an area.</i></p> <p>The resources I need will be... <i>Paper, pen (sometimes a calculator) – you don't need to print a copy, just answer on any paper.</i></p> <p>I should submit my work... <i>Mark your own work, use the recommended clips to improve on MathsWatch. You can contact your maths teacher if you wish further explanation.</i></p>
<p>Science</p>	<p>When and where will my home learning be set? <i>Work will be set on Class Charts every Monday. You should log in and download the materials. This will be the work for all your lessons for that week. Nothing needs to be printed.</i></p> <p>My online lesson will be... <i>Using the EZYEducation website or a pre-recorded session with a member of the science team.</i></p> <p>The resources I need will be... <i>Paper, pencil and pen (or you can complete on the computer/tablet etc if you prefer). You may want highlighters/different coloured pens to help with annotations.</i></p> <p>I should submit my work... <i>Once a week via Class Charts, Google Classroom or email. Your teacher will tell you which to use.</i></p>

Humanities	<p>When and where will my home learning be set? <i>Work will be set on ClassCharts every other Thursday. You should log in and download the materials. This will be the work for all your lessons for that fortnight. If your teacher has set up a Google Classroom, it may also be uploaded to there.</i></p> <p>My online lesson will be... <i>Videod content will be provided but may be a range of YouTube clips and documentaries.</i></p> <p>The resources I need will be.. <i>Paper and pen (you can complete on the computer/tablet etc if you prefer). You may want highlighters/different coloured pens to help with annotations.</i></p> <p>I should submit my work... <i>Once a fortnight via ClassCharts or Google Classroom (depending on if your teacher is using it).</i></p>
Technology	<p>Design and Technology:</p> <p>When and where work will my home learning be set: <i>Work will be set weekly for students to appear on the Google Classroom depending on the teacher's arrangement with the students: some of the work will be individually set on the Google Classroom based on communications between the teacher and student.</i></p> <p>My on line lesson will be: <i>The lesson can be in many forms: normally it will be written instructions that will often link to an ongoing piece of coursework. Students will be using google classroom where resources are easily attached to the sequence of lessons.</i></p> <p>I should submit my work <i>By direct email to the teacher or via the Google Classroom link- whatever is easier for the students: it is important that the students save their work in their own electronic folder so that we can build on it as in most cases it is vital coursework evidence. A weekly submission is requested.</i></p> <p>Food/Catering:</p> <p>When and where will my home learning be set? <i>Work will be set on Google Classroom every Wednesday. You should log in and download the materials. This will be the work for all your lessons for that week.</i></p> <p>The resources I need will be.. <i>Paper and pen (you can complete on the computer/tablet etc if you prefer). You may want highlighters/different coloured pens to help with annotations.</i></p> <p>I should submit my work... <i>Once a week via Google Classroom, this can include any photos of dishes you have made.</i></p>
Art	<p>When and where will my home learning be set? <i>Tasks will be set on Google Classroom and Classcharts weekly or biweekly dependant on task. You should login to check the task carefully and open any attachments. Work should be photographed/scanned back to us and submitted via Google Classrooms.</i></p> <p>My online lesson will be... <i>Online tutorials will be posted for specific tasks to teach skills or show examples. This will be pre-recorded and posted when required.</i></p> <p>The resources I need will be..</p>

	<p><i>Paper, pencil, biro, mobile phone/camera, charging lead. If possible a printer, coloured pencils, paints, paintbrush, glue and scissors dependant on subject.</i></p> <p>I should submit my work...</p> <p><i>Work should be photographed/scanned back to us and submitted via Google Classrooms. OR direct us to where you have saved it in your documents.</i></p>
PE	<p>When and where will my home learning be set?</p> <p><i>All BTEC PE work has been set on ClassCharts. Pupils have initially been tasked with completing the merit and distinction part of the unit 3 evaluation which is to be e-mailed to their class teacher. Once this is completed pupils will be tasked with completing their unit 2 work which they have been doing this year and also introduce and learn the unit 1 content to prepare them to sit their exam before Christmas in year 11.</i></p> <p>My online lesson will be...</p> <p><i>Unit content from the specification, Templates and guidance to complete unit 3 to merit / distinction standard. PowerPoints or recorded lessons of unit 1 will be put on ClassCharts for pupils to learn and if school remains closed beyond the May ½ term online tests will be set to check pupils understanding.</i></p> <p>The resources I need will be..</p> <p><i>Computer to access the work on ClassCharts, research and complete the work before e-mailing it back to their class teacher.</i></p> <p>I should submit my work...</p> <p><i>Pupils have been set a deadline for each piece of work and it needs to be e-mailed to their class teacher who will be marking as per the BTEC guidance. Teachers will e-mail any pupils who do not complete the work by the deadline and call home if any work still not completed to ensure all pupils are up to date and in a good place to achieve a high grade when they return.</i></p>
Performing Arts	<p>Music:</p> <p>When and where will my home learning be set?</p> <p><i>Google Classroom and Class charts. Weekly with the work being set on each Monday.</i></p> <p>My online lesson will be...</p> <p><i>With Miss Graham and Mr Saturley. The project will be available on ClassCharts.</i></p> <p>The resources I need will be..</p> <p><i>Paper and pen (you can complete on the computer/tablet etc if you prefer). You may want highlighters/different coloured pens to help with annotations.</i></p> <p>I should submit my work...</p> <p><i>The Monday after the work has been set.</i></p> <p>Drama:</p> <p>When and where will my home learning be set?</p> <p><i>Work will be set at the start of each of half term on class charts. There will be additional tasks linked to the Drama Project. Should additional tasks be set they will appear on a Monday.</i></p> <p>BTEC course. <i>In addition to this project you must complete your learning log entries for Component One relating to the workshops on Naturalism and Non-Naturalism. Details on how to do this will be sent via class charts.</i></p> <p>The resources I need will be</p> <p><i>Work templates and worksheets with information on the set tasks need to be accessed by computer. Students can use these templates to type their work or write on paper (hand written work will need to be photographed and emailed once the task is due).</i></p> <p><i>Research can be done on computer, tablet or smartphones.</i></p> <p>I should submit my work</p> <p><i>Details of submission dates will be set along with the individual task on class charts. Work should be sent to Mr Mearns by email.</i></p>
IT	<p>When and where will my home learning be set?</p> <p><i>Work will be set on Class Charts on Wednesday every week. You will need your school google account login to access google classroom where you will be able to download the resources required for the session. This will be the work for all your lessons for that week.</i></p>

	<p>My online lesson will be... <i>As the resources are ongoing project based learning there will be no formal online sessions as the presentations and worksheets are provided. Support will be provided through using the comments stream in google classroom to ask any questions in regards to the work.</i></p> <p>The resources I need will be.. <i>Access to a computer tablet or mobile phone. Resources are cloud based so can be accessed and worked on with any internet connected device.</i></p> <p>I should submit my work... <i>Once a week via Google classroom.</i></p>
