Humanities	<p>When and where will my home learning be set? Work will be set on ClassCharts every other Tuesday. You should log in and download the materials. This will be the work for all your lessons for that fortnight. If your teacher has set up a Google Classroom, it may also be uploaded to there.</p> <p>My online lesson will be... Videoed content will be provided but may be a range of YouTube clips and documentaries.</p> <p>The resources I need will be.. Paper and pen (you can complete on the computer/tablet etc if you prefer). You may want highlighters/different coloured pens to help with annotations.</p> <p>I should submit my work... Once a fortnight via ClassCharts or Google Classroom (depending on if your teacher is using it).</p>
Technology	<p>Design Technology:</p> <p>When and where work will my home learning be set: Work will be set for students to appear in class charts on the day of their lesson.</p> <p>My on line lesson will be: The lesson can be in many forms: normally it will be written instructions that will often link to worksheets with research directed either from websites or attached information.</p> <p>I should submit my work By direct email to the teacher or via class charts- whatever is easier for the students: it is important that the students save their work in their own electronic folder so that we can build on it. A weekly submission is requested.</p> <p>Food/Catering:</p> <p>When and where will my home learning be set? A Food Technology booklet was sent out on ClassCharts before the Easter half term. A reminder about work and where you should be will be set on ClassCharts every Wednesday. You should log in and download the materials as you will need to complete the different tasks in the booklet. You can also print off the booklet if you prefer. This will be the work for all your lessons for the next 7 weeks.</p> <p>The resources I need will be.. Your booklet completed online or printed out and pen to complete work. If you're able to complete any cooking you can also take a photo of each dish you make.</p> <p>I should submit my work... Once a week via Class Charts. You can submit any photos of your practical work this way too.</p>
Art	<p>When and where will my home learning be set? Tasks will be set on Google Classroom and ClassCharts weekly or biweekly dependant on task. You should login to check the task carefully and open any attachments. Work should be photographed/scanned back to us and submitted via Google Classrooms.</p> <p>My online lesson will be... Online tutorials will be posted for specific tasks to teach skills or show examples. This will be pre-recorded and posted when required.</p> <p>The resources I need will be.. Paper, pencil, biro. If possible coloured pencils, paints, paintbrush, glue and scissors.</p> <p>I should submit my work... Once completed submit your work via Google Classrooms.</p>
PE	<p>When and where will my home learning be set? Home learning has and will continue to be set on class charts and consists of practical suggestions of how to stay active including recording sheets to track progress and online websites with practical ideas to do at home. Pupils have also been given PowerPoints explaining theory they need to learn to</p>

	<p>prepare them for an end of KS3 test which is the same one they did at the start of the year 7 to check an improvement of their theory understanding in preparation for KS4.</p> <p>The resources I need will be..</p> <p>Computer to access their ClassCharts and internet to research the practical ideas to exercise at home. The equipment needed is minimal in most the practical examples and can be done with no equipment and use their phone to support workouts.</p> <p>I should submit my work...</p> <p>Pupils have not been asked to submit their work at present but would be good to see the progress pupils have made on their recording sheets. The theory work is for the pupils to research independently and prepare to redo the test they did at the start of the year which will be set as home learning to be submitted if school remains closed beyond the May ½ term holiday.</p>
Performing Arts	<p>Music:</p> <p>When and where will my home learning be set?</p> <p>On the first Monday of each half term (Half term Project). The project will be available on ClassCharts.</p> <p>My online lesson will be...</p> <p>With Mr Saturley and Mr Mearns.</p> <p>The resources I need will be..</p> <p>Paper and pen (you can complete on the computer/tablet etc if you prefer). You may want highlighters/different coloured pens to help with annotations.</p> <p>I should submit my work...</p> <p>The first Monday of half term.</p> <p>Drama:</p> <p>When and where will my home learning be set?</p> <p>Work will be set at the start of each of half term on class charts. There will be additional tasks linked to the Drama Project. Should additional tasks be set they will appear on a Monday.</p> <p>The resources I need will be</p> <p>Work templates and worksheets with information on the set tasks need to be accessed by computer. Students can use these templates to type their work or write on paper (hand written work will need to be photographed and emailed once the task is due).</p> <p>Research can be done on computer, tablet or smartphones.</p> <p>I should submit my work</p> <p>Details of submission dates will be set along with the individual task on class charts. Work should be sent to Mr Mearns by email.</p>
IT	<p>When and where will my home learning be set?</p> <p>Work will be set on Class Charts on Wednesday every week. You will need your school google account login to access google classroom where you will be able to download the resources required for the session. This will be the work for all your lessons for that week.</p> <p>My online lesson will be...</p> <p>As the resources are ongoing project based learning there will be no formal online sessions as the presentations and worksheets are provided. Support will be provided through using the comments stream in google classroom to ask any questions in regards to the work</p> <p>The resources I need will be..</p> <p>Access to a computer tablet or mobile phone. Resources are cloud based so can be accessed and worked on with any internet connected device</p> <p>I should submit my work...</p> <p>Once a week via Google classroom.</p>
