Spotlight on.....Apprenticeships



Next week is National Apprenticeship week, so this half term's edition of Careers News will focus upon apprenticeships and signpost to the many different resources and events available to find out more.

What is an apprenticeship?

An apprenticeship is a real job with a contract of employment and a paid salary. In addition, at least 20% of the time (equivalent to 1 day per week) will be spent undertaking training.

There are apprenticeship opportunities in every sector, with many qualifications that can lead to very impressive job roles in management. Some apprentices go on to win national awards, become Chief Executives, set up their own businesses and even have teams of apprentices working for them.

There are lots of new apprenticeships that have been created covering a huge range of job roles and industries. For example, did you know there are now apprenticeships like these....?

- Aerospace Engineer designing and maintaining aircraft or working on space vehicles and satellites
- Cyber Intrusion Analyst carrying out crucial work monitoring networks and detecting breaches in security
- Digital Journalist creating engaging content for TV, radio and online
- •Food Technologist ensuring the safety and quality of food and researching and developing new flavours and products
- Architect working on the design of new buildings and the redesign of existing buildings

Unlike applying to college or university, there isn't one deadline and each employer will recruit differently. There are ways to make it easier though. The government has a website called 'Find an apprenticeship' where you can search for apprenticeship jobs where, on average, there are around 23,000 opportunities listed each month!
