
## **CARNEGE MEDAL SHORTLIST 2021 – join the debate!**

It is the time of year that Library and English staff at **Teignmouth Community School** look forward to most – it is spring and the annual **Shadowing scheme for the CILIP Carnegie Medal** is now underway! The Carnegie Medal is the nation's oldest, most prestigious children's book award. It is awarded every year by children's librarians for an outstanding book written in English for children and young people.



This year's shortlist has now been revealed, the judges have been "drawn towards optimistic books that offer an escape from a year of lockdown. Themes of freedom, the Great Outdoors, and the natural world all feature heavily". Multiple copies of each title have been added to our library stock and reading can commence from now until the middle of June when the final winners are announced.

However, the Shadowing will also be introduced to Y7 and Y8 students in English and Reading lessons. This popular reading for pleasure scheme has thousands of registered

school groups and reading groups in the UK and overseas, who read, review and discuss the shortlisted books to 'shadow' the judging process and select their favourites. It is a brilliant way to enjoy and interact with the very best current writing for children and young people. Students and staff also have the opportunity to vote for their favourite novel for the **Shadower's Choice Medal** which is awarded along-side the official medal.
