#### Year 10 Mock Interviews



This half term our Year 10 students were given the opportunity to experience a mock interview hosted by representatives from various businesses and further and higher education institutions.

Students had to submit their CVs prior to the interviews which were held virtually this year, and were each given a 15 minute slot to discuss their experience, answer guestions and receive constructive feedback. The mock interviews give students a professional and genuine interview experience and despite the change in format, our students adjusted well to the online interviews and communicated positively with interviewers. This practise experience is extremely valuable and will enable our students to approach future college and job interviews with confidence.

Feedback from the three days was very positive from students and interviewers alike, with many of our young people pleased with how their interview went. One student commented "it isn't as scary as you think, so don't overthink it and be confident." Another student commented on the virtual set up saying "I think it was really good because there is a high chance of us having to do interviews this way in the future." The overwhelming majority though, felt they would have preferred to have completed it in person so we hope to revert back to our usual face to face interviews next year.

62 students from across the year group were selected by interviewers as having given an outstanding interview and they were presented with a certificate of achievement - Congratulations!

## Virtual Work Experience (VWEX)



Speakers for Schools have added many more virtual work experience placements for the summer term for students from Year 10 and up. Students can access their portal to apply for placements from a wide range of industries which is completely free. There are some incredible opportunities that would never have been accessed through traditional work experience as students can now apply for opportunities all over the country. Check out these short videos from students who have already taken part in VWEX with Speakers for Schools to find out how it can give a confidence boost, open eyes to new opportunities and help make connections.

Opportunities range from a 1 day insight day, to a 3 day and 5 day work experience placement. All placements are designed to be learning experiences that help students better understand the world of work, gain transferable skills and valuable insights about industries to help pave the way for their next steps. If any Year 10 or Y12 student is successful in applying for a placement, time will be authorised as absence from school and they can then take part from home on these days.
