Fine Art includes a multitude of ways to work, this can include: Drawing, painting, sculpture, installation, lens-/light-based media, photography and the moving image, printmaking, mixed media, land art.

During your GCSE you will learn and demonstrate skills such as:

- ❖ Mark-making
- ❖ Monoprint, collagraph and block printing
- ❖ Digital working methods
- ❖ Use media and materials, as appropriate to students' personal intentions, for example:
- ❖ Charcoal, pastels, pen and ink, crayons and pencil
- ❖ Watercolour, gouache, acrylic and oil paint
- ❖ Found materials
- ❖ Clay, wood and metal
- ❖ Digital imagery
- ❖ Different papers and surfaces on which to work.

Portraiture, location photography, studio photography, experimental imagery, installation, documentary photography, photo-journalism, moving image: film, video and animation, fashion photography.

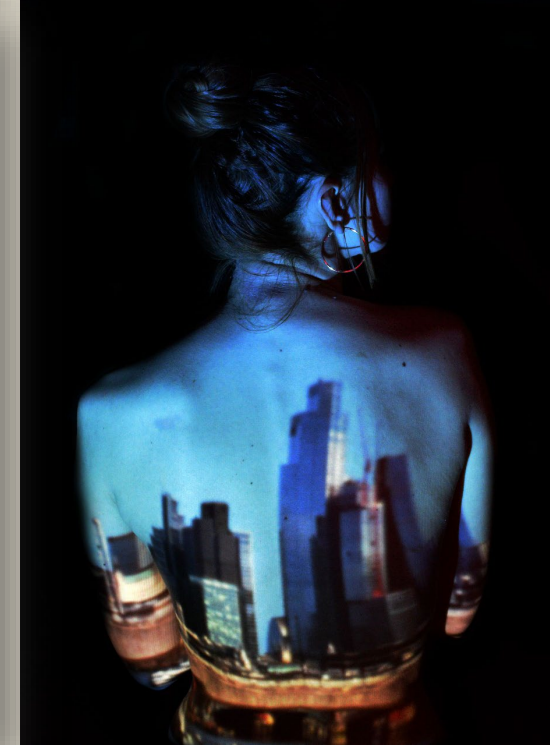
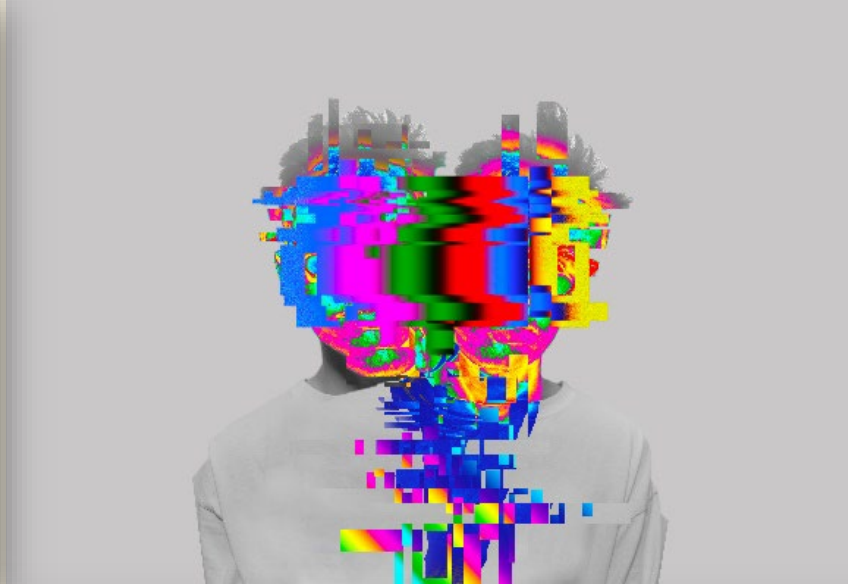
During your GCSE you will learn and demonstrate skills such as:

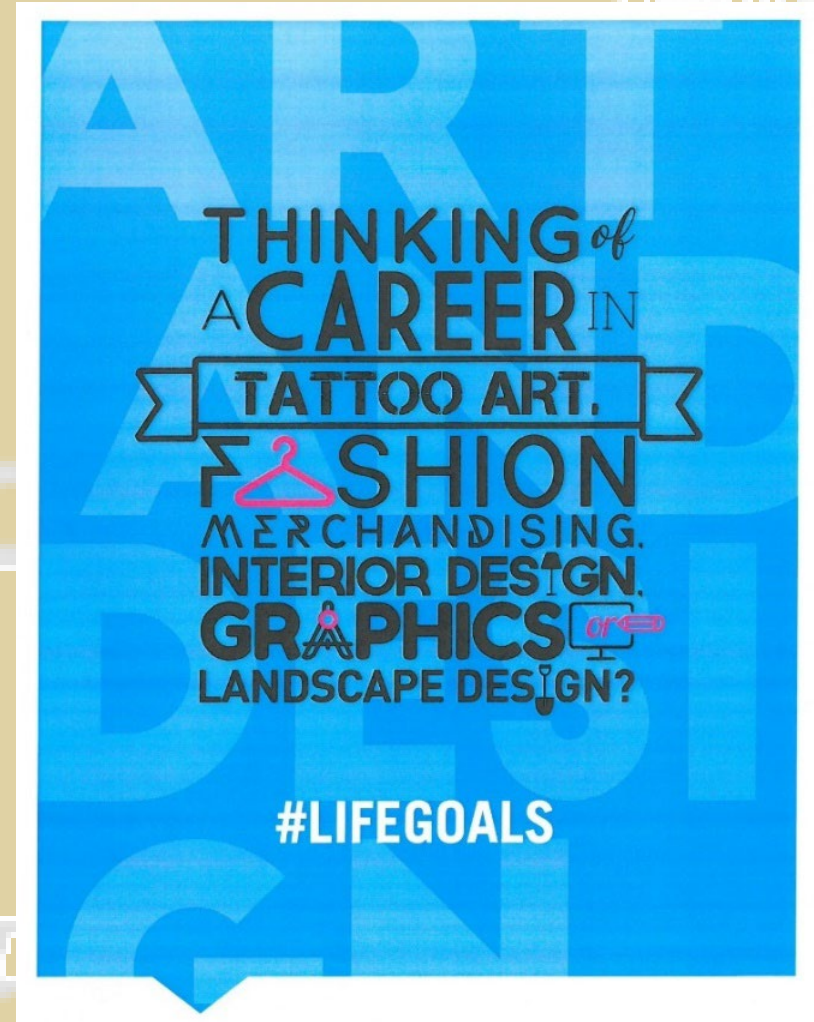

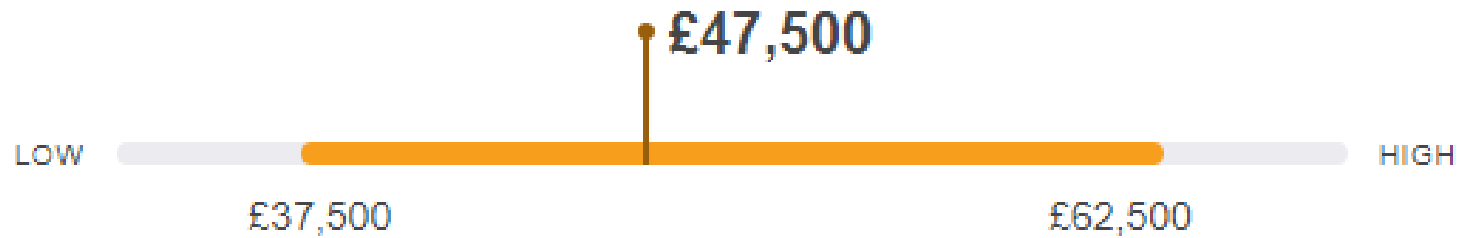

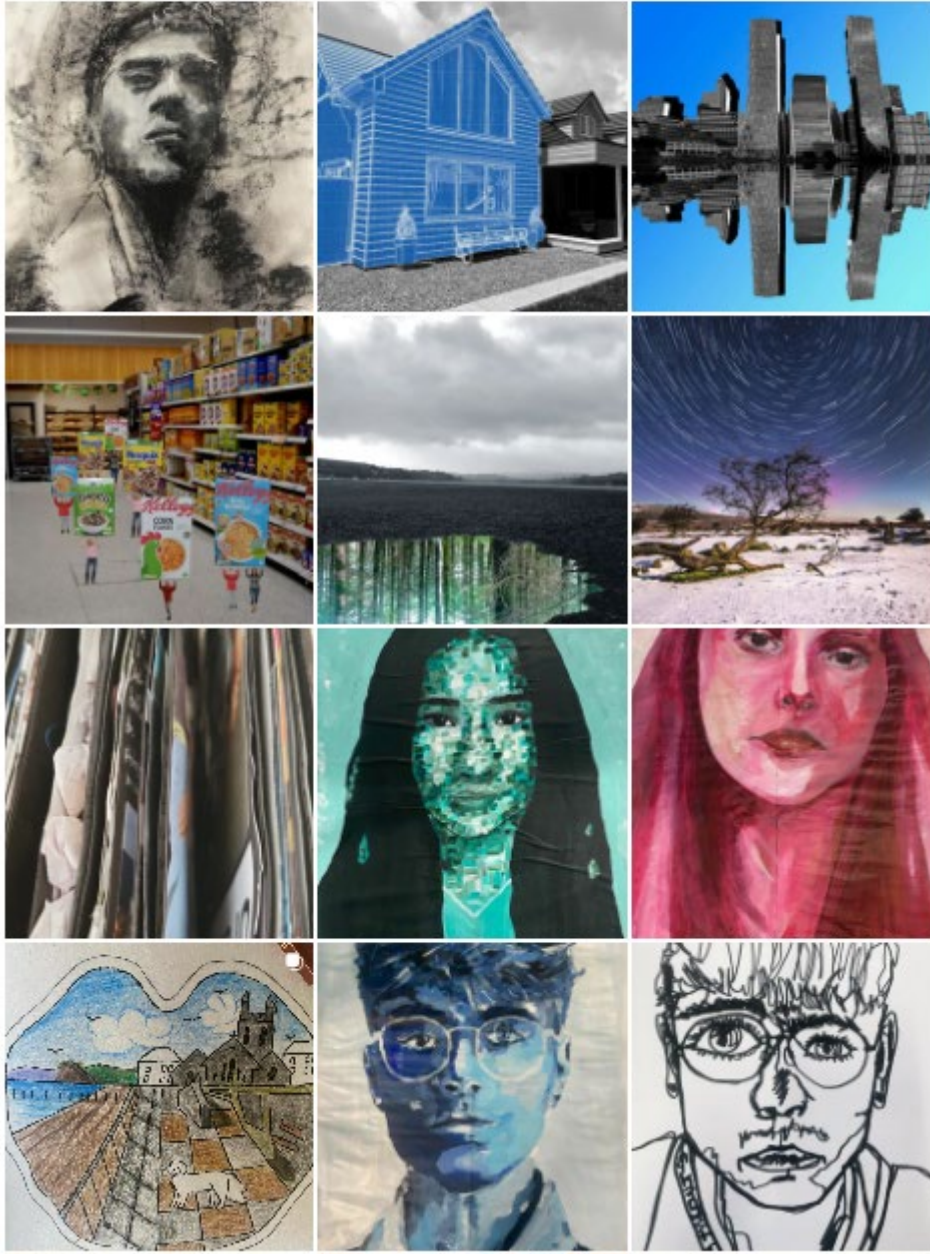
