## YOUR CHILD'S HPV VACCINATION IS NOW DUE

Girls and boys aged 12-14 in school year 8 are offered the HPV (Human Papilloma Virus) vaccination as part of the NHS childhood immunisation programme. The vaccine protects against HPV related cancers such as cervical cancer in women, penile cancer in men and throat and neck cancers in both men and women; it is offered at schools in England as a one dose course.

According to Cancer Research UK, cervical cancer is the second most common cancer in women under the age of 35. In the UK, 2900 women a year are diagnosed with cervical cancer - that is around eight women each day. It is estimated that about 400 lives could be saved every year in the UK as a result of vaccinating girls before they are infected with HPV. The number of diagnoses of genital warts in England has also fallen sharply in both girls and boys since the vaccination programme started, suggesting that boys had started to already benefit indirectly from the girls' programme through 'herd immunity' protection. Extension of the HPV programme to boys will save even more lives.
