• If you have already submitted a form giving consent for the HPV vaccination in Devon, and your child has not received the vaccine, please re-submit a new consent. If you are unsure, please call the team 01392 342678 for Devon schools and 01872 221105 for Cornwall schools and we will be able to advise. If you have consented and now wish to withdraw consent, please contact Kernow Health in the first instance.

- We will be visiting the school on the 17th April 2024 and again later in the year as well as running some community catch-up clinics at various venues around the county. We will give every opportunity for you to have your child immunised. Please submit your consent form by midday on the 14th April 2024 in order to ensure your child receives their vaccination.
- Your child can self-consent to treatment if they are considered competent to do so by one of our nurses; this is known as Gillick competency. If you require any further information in this regard, please contact us or go to https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/consent-to-treatment/children/

If a consent form is not submitted your child might not be vaccinated.
